


2018 Total Revenue: \$589,620

2018 Total Expenses: \$338,865





The expectation of the Children's Critical Care Fund is to end the cycle of homelessness, poverty, addiction and abuse. The ultimate goal is to prevent their return to Star of Hope as adults.

With the support of generous donors, Trees of Hope has been able to donate over \$10.2 million to Star of Hope since 1990.
